

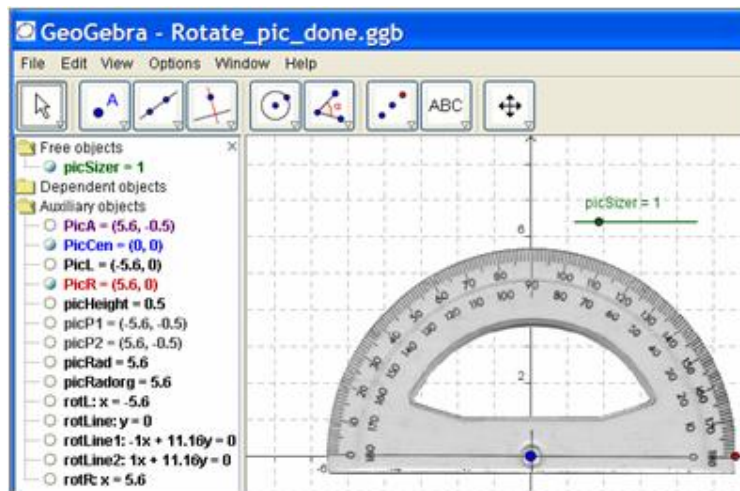


Making a freely moving, rotating and resizing picture

1. Open Rotate_pic.ggb
 2. Right-click on the protractor image (pic1) and select Delete.
 3. Select the Insert Image icon .
 4. Click anywhere in the drawing pad.
 5. Select your image.
 6. Click on the Move icon .
 7. **Click and drag your image** until the blue point **PicCen** is in the center point of rotation that you want.
 8. Click and drag the big purple point **PicA** is in the bottom right corner of the picture.
 9. Hide everything but **PicCen**, **PicR** and **picSizer**.
 10. Click File -> SaveAs and rename your file to a filename of your choice.
- You can use this new ggb file as a starter file *or*
 - Follow the directions [here](#) to add these elements to an existing ggb file – just don't forget to rename your picture to pic10 if you already have an image in your existing ggb file!
